What is a Serve Team?

Serve Teams are teams that serve in New City's in-house ministries.

How are Serve Teams different from Grow+Serve Groups?

Serve Teams focus mostly on serving the church, the people *inside* the church; and Grow+Serve groups focus on serving the city and people *outside* the church. In addition, Serve Teams usually focus on serving while Grow+Serve groups learn together, do life together, pray together, AND serve the city.

WHAT WE DO: Welcome Newcomers at a 10minute party after each service & help connect them to the church.

WHAT A VOLUNTEER CAN DO: Host a Newcomers 10minute party 1-2x a month. Includes set-up/tear-down of chairs, cupcakes (already provided), juice, & hanging signs. Greet all Newcomers making them feel welcome until the pastors arrive to speak.

13a. NewCityKidz! Set-up Team

WHAT WE DO: Make sure the children's ministry rooms are equipped & ready for the kids to arrive.

WHAT A VOLUNTEER CAN DO: On Sunday mornings, gather all the required items from the "cage" (storage room), move them to the appropriate rooms (all on rollable carts), then set-up those materials.

13b. Mini NewCityKidz! (infant/toddler) Team

WHAT WE DO: Provide a safe & nurturing environment to introduce infants/toddlers to Jesus & free their parents to worship.

WHAT A VOLUNTEER CAN DO: One Sunday per month, care for, nurture, sing to, & pray over the babies and toddlers during the worship gathering. An application process is required.

13c. NewCityKidz! (preschool-5th grade) Team

WHAT WE DO: Disciple the children of New City.

WHAT A VOLUNTEER CAN DO: Build relationships with & lead a Bible lesson for children in Bubbles (3-5 yrs. old), Splash (K - 2nd grade), or Xstream (3rd - 5th grade). You pick the age you prefer. The lesson plan is provided. An application process is required.
